


Montgomery, New York

Montgomery is one of 62 [counties](#) in New York. It is part of the Amsterdam, NY Micropolitan Statistical Area. Its 2009 population of 48,616 ranked 51st in the state.


PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2009 Montgomery had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,490. This PCPI ranked 41st in the state and was 70 percent of the state average, \$46,516, and 82 percent of the national average, \$39,635. The 2009 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.6 percent from 2008. The 2008-2009 state change was -3.4 percent and the national change was -2.6 percent. In 1999 the PCPI of Montgomery was \$22,600 and ranked 35th in the state. The 1999-2009 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.6 percent and for the nation was 3.4 percent.


In 2009 Montgomery had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,579,556*. This TPI ranked 48th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1999 the TPI of Montgomery was \$1,128,128* and ranked 47th in the state.

*Note: Total personal income estimates are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Montgomery.
